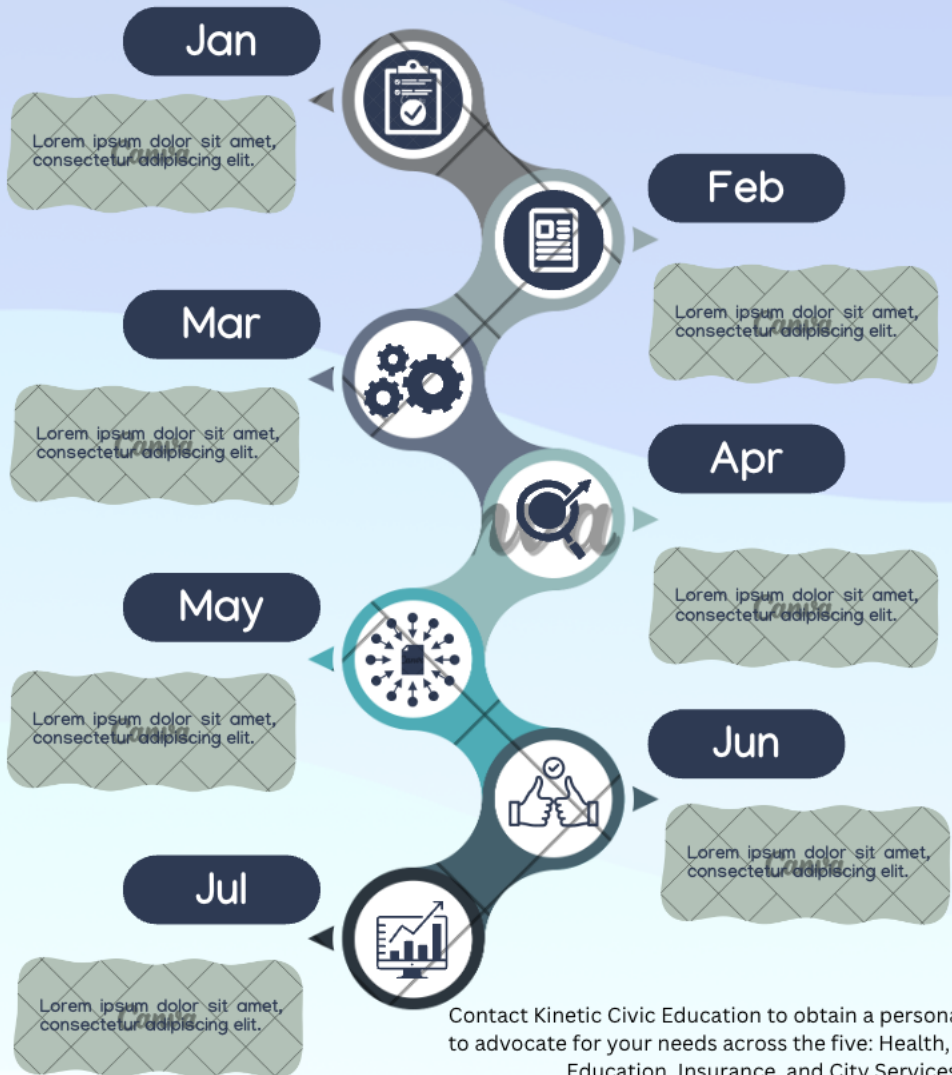

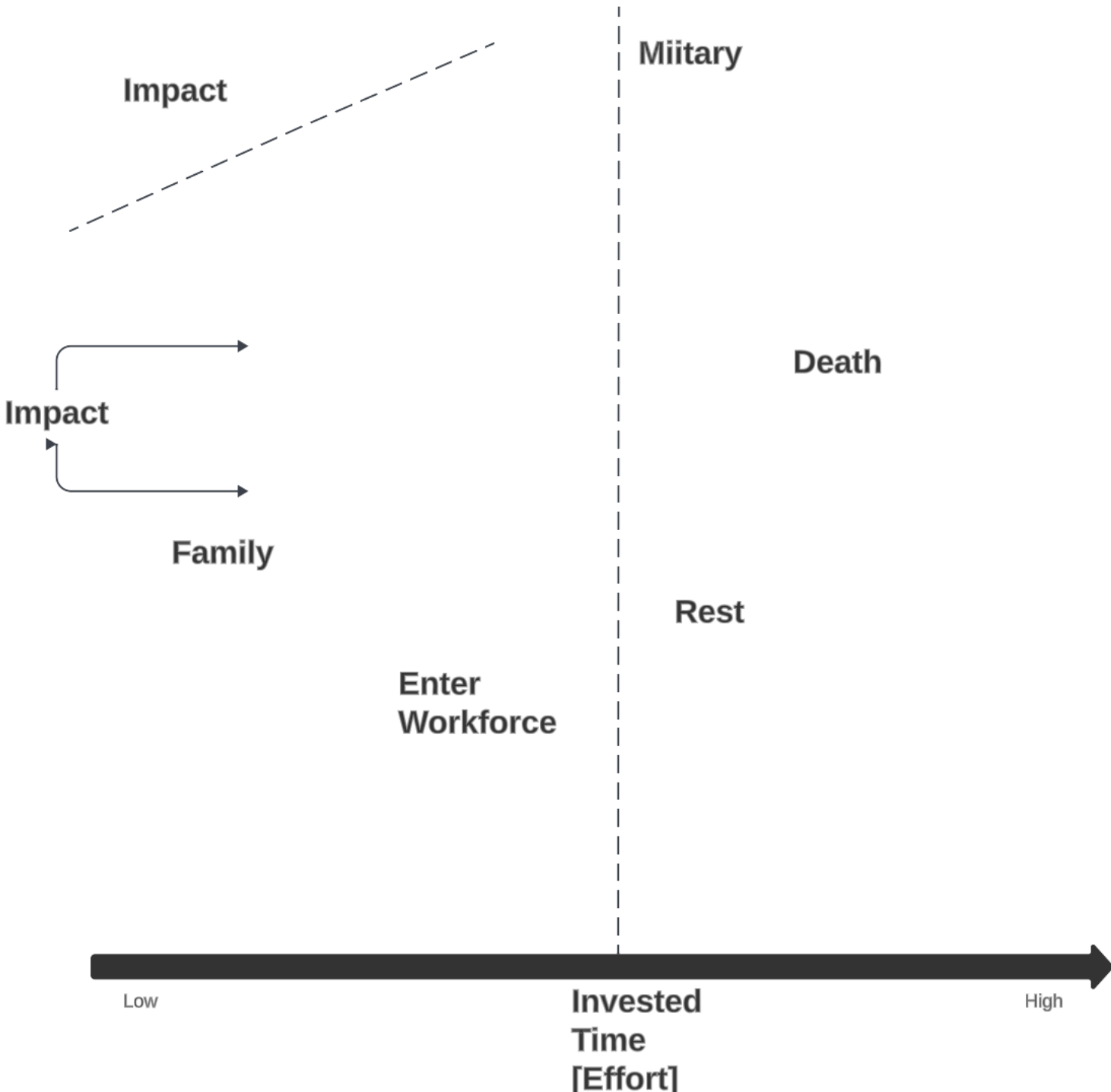


Key thoughts

The various primary sources I relied on experienced these situations in their district even though they were not solely using services from within their district. My brother's surgeon was unhygienic, kept the dentistry tools out in the open, vulnerable to cross contamination, and got upset when my brother started asking her about the sanitizing procedure before knocked him out. She got angry and left, then we got up and walked out the front door. Weeks later, we called the insurance company to make sure everything was cancelled and it turns out that she charged him for the removal of all four wisdom teeth even though he never received the service and waited four months before he was able to get them out by a different surgeon.

Predict + Challenge = Great Questions




